

Cllr Egginton – County Report – January 2026

Just a few points to update.

The gulley grids at endon, opposite the black horse, are being cleaned this Monday coming.

The gulleys by the trinity church, Stockton brook, have been investigated and there is an inherent problem.

But they are cleaned and jetted Thursday or Friday.

A further investigation will be carried out in due course.

At brown edge pc I asked cllr flunder if he can look into this and perhaps clarify as we regard him to be the expert in this field.

The gulley grid at station road opposite the cricket club, has been repaired but at county we are not satisfied with the works carried out and they have agreed to return and increase the height of the gulley.

I called also and had a look at the plough mural, it seems to be holding at the moment. Despite all the rain and frost .

The lay-by at the endon grill has been reported to highways and further discussions are in progress.

Several Public footpath issues have been reported, I am working my way through the backlog.

White bridge has been reported to prow and

Rural countryside panel. This has been mentioned at the prow panel.

I have completed my own inspection on the bridge, and in my opinion it is in a serious structural condition and in danger of collapse.

Again more research by myself and the prow panel and officers following discussions after we attended more training on the subject at county.

Also i sent the clerk the dates for the yellow lines to be installed at the corners on the above junction .
